THEATRE TRIP – THE WIPERS TIMES

16th November 2017 – Everyman Theatre, Cheltenham

The Wipers Times, written by Ian Hislop and Nick Newman, tells the true and extraordinary story of the satirical newspaper created in the mud and mayhem of the Somme during the First World War. Two officers find a printing press in a bombed-out building in Ypres (mispronounced Wipers by British soldiers) and create a newspaper for the troops. They produce a resolutely cheerful, subversive and funny newspaper designed to lift the spirits of the men on the front line. The Wipers Times was a tribute to the resilience of the human spirit in the face of overwhelming adversity.

The ticket price is £31.50 and the coach will leave Stow square at 11:00. We should arrive at the theatre at approximately 11:45, allowing time for everyone to enjoy lunch or some retail therapy in Cheltenham before the performance starts at 14:00. We should be back in Stow shortly before 17:30.
